AMA Adopts Policies to Address Challenges in Medical Education



The American Medical Association (AMA) House of Delegates convened its Interim Meeting on November 12 and adopted a series of policies to address challenges in medical education and the physician workforce.

Delegates adopted policy aimed at giving greater urgency to addressing the worsening primary care physician shortage in rural areas by supporting a comprehensive review of the Health Professional Shortage Area (HPSA) scoring system used by the National Health Service Corps (NHSC) Loan Repayment Program.

Delegates adopted policy aimed at reducing the financial and administrative burdens associated with reporting CME requirements for physicians by simplifying CME reporting by promoting a common reporting standard across medical specialty and state medical boards.
